This year's joint conference was decided to be held in memory of the late president of ILSA Dr. Sadamu Ishikawa who suddenly passed away in April 2019.

In aspiration for continuing lung sounds research, JLSA decides to host the 44<sup>th</sup> ILSA annual conference, in conjunction with the 44<sup>th</sup> annual conference of JLSA, as a Dr. Ishikawa memorial conference in Nagoya on November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019 (Sunday). Consequently, however, the conference will be held in a limited framework. The joint session is planned to have a half day program where presentations in all fields of lung sounds research

are welcome.
